2. In this room there's a boat covered with soft bulging shapes. Start by looking at it closely. Now close your eyes and think about what it would be like to row that boat. What do you call a boat that goes under water?

3. These sculptures are covered with the same bulging shapes as the boat you looked at before. The sculptures are standing on something you can eat. What is it?

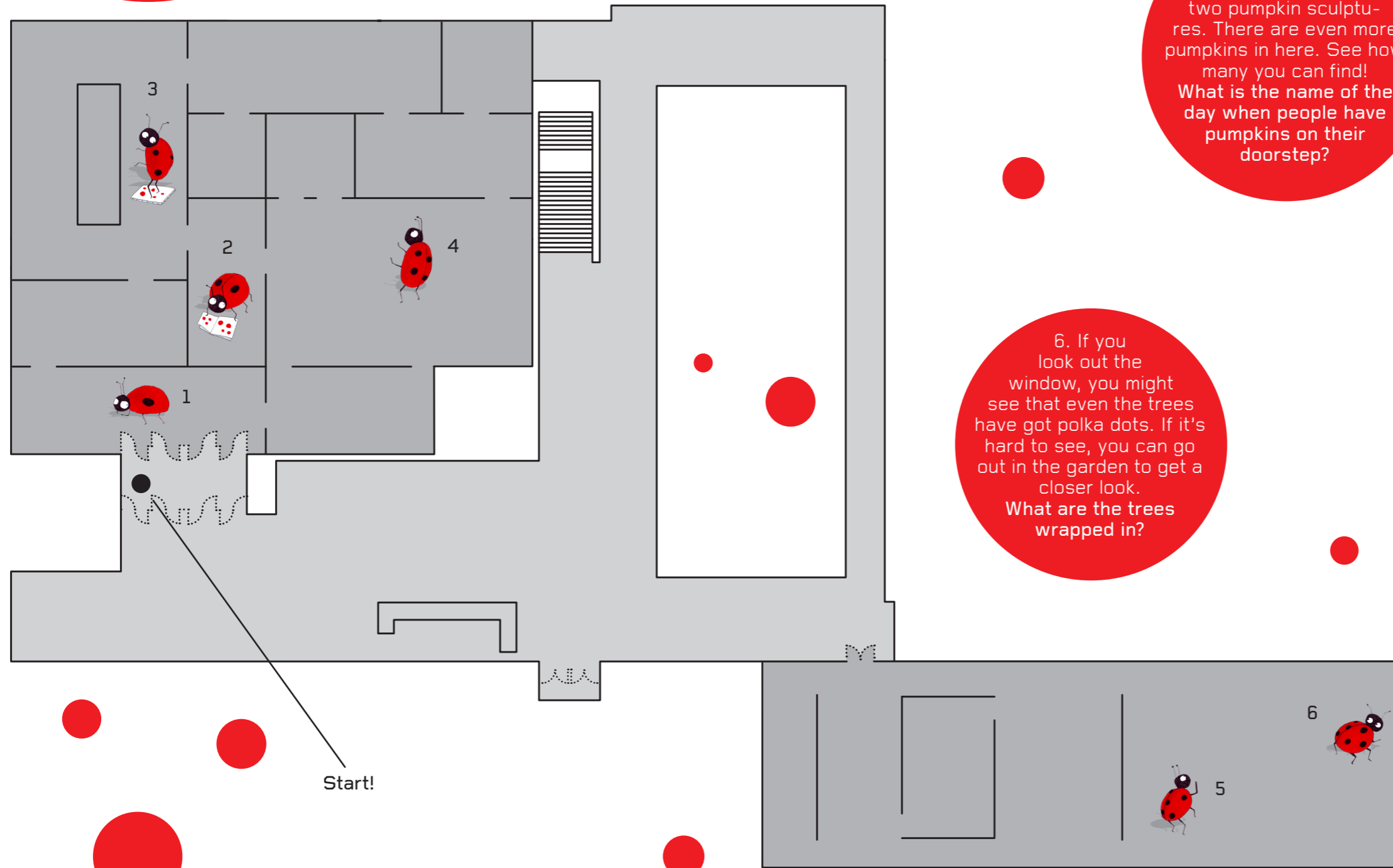

Yes, what do you think?

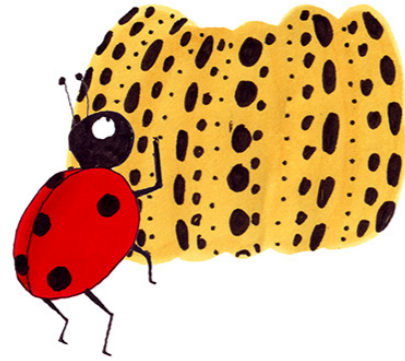
6. If you look out the window, you might see that even the trees have got polka dots. If it's hard to see, you can go out in the garden to get a closer look. What are the trees wrapped in?
