How to access images from the archive

The Moderna Museet image archive contains photographs of art and photography in the Moderna Museet collection. It also includes images from exhibitions and other activities over the years.

These images can be ordered at bildbyran@modernamuseet.se.

The fee depends on how you intend to use the image.

Researchers and other visitors can request images for viewing in the Moderna Museet research library on Thursdays, by appointment. Please book your visit with bildbyran@modernamuseet.se.

If you wish to reproduce an image of a work of art, it is your responsibility to apply for permission and pay for the "image copyright". To do this, please contact the Visual Arts Copyright Society in Sweden (BUS), www.bus.se, the artist, or the artist's estate.

If you intend to reproduce a photographic work, it is your responsibility to also apply for permission and pay for the photographic copyright. To do this, please contact the photographer, or the photographer's estate. Please address any questions concerning this to the Association of Swedish Professional Photographers at www.sffoto.se.

If the artist or photographer has been dead for 70 years, the image is no longer protected by copyright, but the Moderna Museet still owns the copyright for the photograph of the work.

The copyright of an image of a work of art usually has two owners: the artist who created the work, and the photographer who photographed it. A documentary image (which does not feature any works of art) has only one copyright owner: the photographer.
